



DUAL ENROLLMENT

The dual enrollment campaign's goal is to increase enrollment in dual enrollment courses by 10% year over year at our partner schools. We created five objectives to meet this goal:

- Objective 1: Increase awareness of dual enrollment benefits and information for teachers who are interested in becoming qualified to teach dual enrollment
- Objective 2: Create an incentive program for dual enrollment teachers to increase course enrollment and motivate teachers to become qualified to teach dual enrollment courses
- Objective 3: Identify the dual enrollment courses that are of highest value and aligned to postsecondary institutions
- Objective 4: Create a community of practice where stakeholders can build strong partnerships that result in student success
- Objective 5: Policy work in support of dual enrollment (through the Chamber)

The campaign addresses the following impact areas:

- Increasing availability of and access to college and career pathways aligned to industry demand
- Increasing equitable access to early college credit

Overall, we saw the following outcomes for dual enrollment:



6% increase from 2022-2023 to 2023-2024 in students who enrolled in dual enrollment courses at 18 of our partner high schools



During the 2023-2024 school year, ElevateEdAZ provided \$154,400 in teacher incentives



\$15.5 million for dual enrollment tuition assistance and a teacher incentive was included in the FY 2024 state general funds budget

Additionally, we saw the following outcomes from our transportation grant:



170+ Businesses Engaged



The Business Partnership team offered almost 100 students over 2,700 rides via HopSkipDrive. This resulted in over 47,000 miles traveled by students to job shadows, internships, and career awareness activities.




Through CTE Pathways, students acquire realistic expectations about different industries and the types of careers available. These programs prepare students to work effectively with others, providing a comprehensive model

Career Awareness:


Providing career awareness opportunities allows students to learn about different career pathways, ultimately preparing them for professional advancement.

Dual enrollment courses are a great opportunity to test the waters of college in the safety of a high school class.




Cost Reduction:

Career Z Challenge

The Career Z Challenge seeks to improve student access to high-quality work-based learning (WBL) opportunities and is aligned with the Biden-Harris Administration's "Raise the Bar: Unlocking Career Success" initiative.

ElevateEdAZ is participating in the Career Z Challenge, along with Phoenix Union and Mesa Public Schools, to fortify and synchronize Arizona's educational and workforce objectives, intending to engage more students with disabilities in WBL experiences and establish a baseline for initial goals, with preliminary goals of:



20 students participating in internships overall (19 students placed in internship YTD)



100 students participating in job shadows overall (98 students placed in job shadows YTD)



500 students engaged in career awareness opportunities

(660 students engaged in career awareness activities as of 6/18/24)

National EPIC Challenge

Ten students received the opportunity to participate in the nationwide EPIC Program, sponsored by the U.S. Chamber of Commerce Foundation and Riipen. EPIC offers authentic, employer-sponsored project-based learning, connecting learners and workers through business associations and challenge providers. With its initial success, ElevateEdAZ is planning to offer this challenge for more students in the 2024-2025 school year.



Pathways to Economic Opportunity

The Greater Phoenix Chamber Foundation is supporting Pathways to Economic Opportunity, funded by Valley of the Sun United Way (VSUW). The program conducts outreach to Black and Latino Young Women and in the second year:
