

ElevateEdAZ Dual Enrollment Expansion Teacher Incentive

Dual enrollment is rapidly gaining interest among students in Arizona and across the country, yet there are a limited number of teachers qualified to teach dual enrollment courses. Students who take dual enrollment courses are twice as likely to go to college, earn higher GPAs, and complete their degrees, according to [research](#) by Helios Education Foundation. ElevateEdAZ is looking to increase the number of teachers who can teach dual enrollment courses by providing a one-time \$1,000 incentive for newly qualified teachers.*

Program Eligibility and Guidelines

Teachers who become qualified to teach dual enrollment between April 2024 and June 2026 are eligible for this incentive. Teachers must:

- Be approved to teach a new dual enrollment course with an Arizona post-secondary institution between April 2024 and June 2026 OR:
- Be a current dual enrollment teacher who becomes qualified to teach an additional dual enrollment course (Example: a teacher who currently teaches creative writing dual enrollment course now teaching English 101/102).
- Dual enrollment courses must be on the [ElevateEdAZ list of qualified courses](#). These are courses that have high transferability and/or are part of the AGEC (Arizona General Education Curriculum).
- New dual enrollment course must be verified by direct supervisor.

Payment and Tax Information

- A single disbursement of \$1,000 will be made upon verification of eligibility.
- The Greater Phoenix Chamber Foundation will initiate payments approximately 6-8 weeks after verification. Disbursements will be processed via Bill.com by electronic payment.
- Taxes will not be withheld from the participation payout. DE Expansion Teacher Incentive Program participants are responsible for this during their tax filing.
- A Form 1099-MISC from the Greater Phoenix Chamber Foundation will be provided if indicated by Internal Revenue Service filing guidelines.

Teacher Reporting Process

2. Once received, fill out the Disbursement Agreement, Course Verification Form, and W9 PDFs. Email completed documents to teachercertification@elevateedaz.com
3. Once your documents are under reviews, you will receive an email from BILL.com to create an account for direct deposit payment. **Need more information?**
